It now holds three Exhibitions a year, viz., Main Exhibition, Nov./Dec.; Travelling, May/June; and Open-Air, February. The Main Exhibition is open to all Dominion Arts Societies, the others to South Canterbury only. Present membership (approx.) is working members 100, non-working 80.
