2. For best WATER COLOUR PAINTING £75

CONDITIONS

OF THE COMPETITION

1. This 1959 Centennial Art Competition for South Canterbury's Centennial is open to ALL ARTISTS (Professional or Amateur) resident in New Zealand and being members of any Art Society in New Zealand.
2. There will be an OIL PAINTING SECTION and a WATER COLOUR PAINTING SECTION.
 - (a) The Prize for the best (adjudged) Oil Painting will be £100.
 - (b) The Prize for the best (adjudged) Water Colour Painting will be £75.
3. Entries in both Sections must represent a New Zealand Landscape, or Coastal, River or Lake Scene or Street Scene with or without figures.
4. Each Artist may enter ONE Painting in One Section or ONE Painting in each Section.
5. Each Entry must
 - (1) BE ORIGINAL,
 - (2) BE THE SOLE WORK OF THE ARTIST
 - (3) HAVE BEEN PAINTED SINCE THE 1st DAY OF JANUARY 1958.
6. The size of the painted surface of each entry shall be of or between the following approximate measurements, viz:—
 - (a) OIL PAINTING
MAXIMUM Size 5 square feet (720 sq. ins) Example 30ins x 24ins
MINIMUM Size 3 square feet (432 sq. ins) Example 24ins x 18ins
 - (b) WATER COLOUR
MAXIMUM Size 3 square feet (432 sq. ins) Example 24ins x 18ins
MINIMUM Size 1 square foot (144 sq. ins) Example 14ins x 10ins
7. Each Entry must be RECTANGULAR and SUITABLY FRAMED. Oil Paintings MUST NOT be Glazed. Water Colours MUST BE Glazed. No eye-screws are to be put in.
8. Each Entrant shall:—
 - (1) Have written or typewritten clearly on the back of each Entry: His or Her NAME and FULL ADDRESS.
The TITLE of the Painting, and the medium.
Its PRICE if for Sale and the letters N.F.S. in Capitals and its estimated VALUE if not for Sale.

(2) Complete and sign the ENTRY FORM attached hereto and forward same to—

so that it shall be received not later than the 1st of AUGUST 1959. An ENTRANCE FEE of 10/- for each Entry shall accompany the Entry Form.

9. All Entries must be addressed to the Society and be delivered **CASED, CRATED or WRAPPED**, to Messrs H. GOULD & CO. LTD., 79 Stafford Street, TIMARU, between the 13th and the 20th of August 1959.
10. (a) The Prize winning Entries shall remain the property of the Entrants and therefore may be sold on their account if entered as being for Sale BUT shall be available (whether Sold or not) to the Society until the end of October 1959 to display to the Public anywhere in South Canterbury.
(b) Any Sale made by the Society shall be subject to a Commission to the Society of 10% of the Sale Price.
11. The Society will take all reasonable care but all Entries will at all times and places, on display or otherwise, be entirely at the Entrants' or Owners' Risk.
12. All expenses of forwarding Entries or of their return to the Entrants or Owners and any insurance shall be arranged for and borne by the Entrants or Owners. Any Entrant or Owner desiring any particular mode of return of an Entry shall specially advise the Society in writing accordingly.
13. The Competition will be held in conjunction with the Annual Exhibition of the Society in Timaru in September 1959, and each Entry hung will be marked as being an Entry in the Competition. All Entries will be judged but no guarantee can be given that all Entries will be hung. Entries, whether Sold or Not Sold, shall not be removed till the end of the Exhibition. All Entries **MUST BE REMOVED** not later than 5 p.m. on the day after the close of the Exhibition.
14. Any question as to the eligibility of any Entry for the Competition shall be decided by the Committee of the Society whose decision shall be final.
15. The decisions of the Judge or Judges of the Competition shall be final.
